REGULAR HOURS WILL CONTINUE.

The Asphodel-Norwood Public Library will continue to provide service during our regular operating hours. You must wear a face covering in the Library and you must hand sanitize immediately upon entering.



SERVICES.

The Library is open to borrow/return materials and for computer use only. Browsing is not permitted at this time. You may place an order for books and materials via our website or by calling the front desk during regular operating hours. The book returns at both branches are open 24/7. There are no overdue fines at this time (you will NOT be charged for late items).



LIMITED CAPACITY.

Occupancy will be limited to maintain social distancing. Please follow signs and designated floor markings. 5 persons max at Norwood Branch, 3 persons max at Westwood Branch.



LIMITED COMPUTER USE.

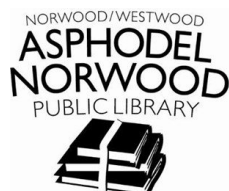
